Title	Title Behavioral Health Payment Reform – Phases 2, 3, 4, and 5 Rates		

This memo is intended to provide an update about **Phases 2, 3, 4, and 5 of Behavioral Health (BH) Payment Reform** implementation to Behavioral Health Services (BHS) contractors that provide Medi-Cal eligible services.

#### **Update: Phase 2 Rate Implementation**

Phase 2 of implementation will shift to January 1, 2024, and will impact:

- Mental Health Residential services
- Mental Health Crisis Residential services

Rates are still being finalized for Phase 2.

#### **Update: Phase 3 Rate Implementation**

Phase 3 of Behavioral Health Payment Reform implementation will shift to January 1, 2024, and will impact:

- Crisis Stabilization Units (CSUs), inclusive of adult and children's services
- Day Treatment Services

The BHS team will continue to provide training and technical assistance to contractors, as needed.

#### **Update: Phase 4, 5, and 6 Rate Implementation**

Phases 4 and 5 of implementation will shift to July 1, 2024, and will impact:

- Substance Use Disorder Outpatient Services
- Mental Health Outpatient Services

Implementation of FFS rates for **Phase 6: Mobile Crisis Teams**, will remain as July 1, 2024.

Rates are still being finalized for Phases 4, 5, and 6.

#### **Amendments**

Due to several providers expressing concerns around equating total budget amounts to minimum annual bed days, the following information is being provided for clarification:

- Contractor budgets included in payment reform amendments were developed using historical analysis.
- CORs and fiscal staff will be closely monitoring contractor spend and utilization to evaluate alternative transition payment and to assess if/when additional funding is needed.
- Contracts requiring additional funding will be amended pursuant to the Contract Services template,
- Article 6, Changes, to align funding amounts with predicted service volume.

## **Future Phase Implementation**

FFS rates for the remaining services under development and proposed implementation dates are subject to change. Communication around future FFS rate implementation will be communicated to contractors via memos.
