

Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery System (DMC-ODS) Peer Support Specialists

To align with the California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) guidelines, this notice replaces the DMC-ODS Peer Support Services grid dated 7/01/21. Effective January 1, 2022, through June 30, 2022, DMC-ODS peer support specialists may perform county-billable case management services after completion of base training. A program base training includes but is not limited to the legal entity's onboarding activities that are required of all staff and the trainings listed on this document.
