


Residential Service Programming Requirements



Clinical Services

- Intake
- Assessment
- Individual Counseling
- Group Counseling*
- Family Therapy
- Collateral Services
- Crisis Intervention Services
- MAT for OUD/AUD
- Recovery Services
- Care Planning
- Discharge Services

Other Services

- Transportation Services (provision of or arrangement for transportation to and from medically necessary treatment).
- Patient Education†
- Facilitated activity (by program staff or providers outside of program). During initial DMC-ODS implementation, programs will have discretion on these facilitated activities.

*Group Counseling can only be provided with 2-12 group participants. Group Counseling focuses on the therapeutic SUD treatment needs of the clients in the group.

†Patient education means providing research based education on addiction, treatment, recovery and associated health risks. Patient education is not considered a clinical activity; and therefore is not subject to a limitation on regard to the number of participants.
